Using fruit names to determine the meter:

Apple = two divisions of the beat = simple meter

Pineapple = three divisions = compound meter

Meter also is classified by the stressed beats (downbeats):

Duple (two beats)
Triple (three beats)
Quadruple (four beats)

The majority of Western art music ("classical music") and American popular music makes use of simple meter.
